1	Cotton bud	2	You may reuse items of similar length
	Pencil / fork / spoon / chopstick	1	If you reuse the utensils from takeaways, please clean them beforehand
	Rubber band / hair tie	4	
2	Fork / spoon / chopstick	1	If you reuse the utensils from takeaways, please clean them beforehand
	Handkerchief	1	 The width and length should be 25-40 cm You may use any fabric that meets the size requirements
	Plastic drinking straw	2	 Please reuse those from takeaways and do not buy new ones Please clean them beforehand
	Old monthly calendar	1	 If not available, draw a calendar on a piece of single-sided paper according to January 2022
	Pen	1	Preferably a marker pen
	Table	1	For placing props and showing the tricks
3	Bottle	1	Preferably a transparent bottle with a narrow mouthYou may reuse a beverage bottle
	Transparent, colourless plastic film	1	You may reuse an old file or an old mask holder
	Basin	1	If not available, use a bucket
	Lemon / orange / apple / pear	1	 If not available, use another kind of soft, fist-sized food, such as a kiwi, a tomato or a bun
	Fork	1	 If not available, use a chopstick If you reuse the utensils from takeaways, please clean them beforehand
	Paper note	4	Plastic ten-dollar notes are not suitable

	Envelope	1	 You may use an old envelope This session would be themed on Easter. Please draw relevant pictures on the envelope.
	Blank paper	5	You may use single-sided paper
